



Teacher Pay Raise

Senate Republicans recently announced the “Teacher Pay Fund,” a plan that will be sent to the ballot next November to provide K-12 public school teachers with raises averaging 7%, or approximately \$4000. This will be done without a tax increase. The dedicated funding source for this will be the Land Trust Endowment, which is constitutionally protected for education spending only. This fund has grown exponentially over the years and is projected to continue to grow. We want to ensure our kids receive a great education and a quality teacher in every classroom. This is a step in the right direction. This proposal was picked up by media outlets across Arizona.

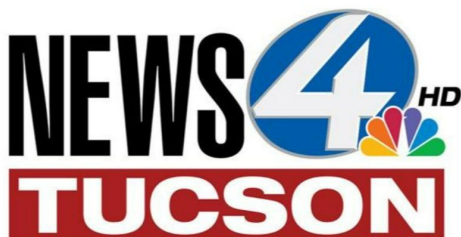
