

ONLY U.S. CITIZENS SHOULD BE ALLOWED TO VOTE In our ongoing efforts to strengthen the integrity of Arizona's elections, I'm proud to share President Petersen is taking legal action to defend our state laws requiring proof of citizenship to vote by mail and to vote in presidential elections. Biden's open border policies are causing chaos and eroding confidence with Arizona voters on who exactly is having an influence in the outcomes of our elections. It would seem like common sense that only American citizens should have the right to cast a ballot, but radical left organizations, Democrats, and the judicial system are fighting against us on this concept. Last week, we filed a motion asking a U.S. district court to allow our state to enforce our proof of citizenship laws for the 2024 election while litigation continues. State law already requires individuals to provide proof of citizenship to vote in state or local races, but federal law only requires individuals to sign a sworn statement saying they are in fact citizens. I'll keep you updated.

MORE SENATE BILLS HEAD TO GOVERNOR'S DESK

We passed several bills out of the Legislature this week with bipartisan support. Among them is a measure I sponsored to establish the act of intentionally disseminating a nonconsensual deepfake recording or image as a felony. The dictionary defines a deepfake as a 'video of a person in which their face or body has been digitally altered so that they appear to be someone else, typically used maliciously or to spread false information.' The use of deepfake media has become a real issue with the increase in artificial intelligence (AI) technology. That leads me to another measure of mine that passed out with near unanimous support. SB 1359 would require a person who distributes a deceptive and fraudulent deepfake of a political candidate within 90 days before an election to include a clear disclosure that the media includes content generated by AI. Failure to disclose this would result in a civil penalty. These very important bills are now headed to the Governor's desk.

EFFORTS TO ADDRESS HOUSING SHORTAGE

Republican lawmakers are committed to solving Arizona's housing shortage, and by working together on this important issue, we've successfully had several bills signed into law this session that will truly make a difference. My bill, SB 1162, will cut the unnecessary government red tape responsible for prolonging approvals on zoning applications needed for home construction to begin. HB2720, which I cosponsored, was also signed into law and will allow homeowners to build accessory dwelling units, such as casitas, on their property. This will especially benefit our elderly population as well as young adults just entering the workforce. As a former travel nurse, I know this will also make a difference for our medical community. HB2721 is another measure I co-sponsored. This new law tackles zoning measures to allow for more middle housing options, such as duplexes and triplexes. Our housing shortage is a complex issue that needs to be addressed in several different areas, and we're taking steps in the right direction. -Senator Janae Shamp
